When you hear Westerners (西方人) say "Drop in anytime" (随时来玩) or "Come and see me soon", you should realize that it doesn't mean you are welcome to come over to their house at anytime. It's wise to telephone first if you are really going to visit someone.

Never accept an invitation unless you really plan to go. You may refuse by saying, "Thank you for inviting me, but I may not be able to come." If you are not able to come after accepting the invitation, be sure to tell those who invite you in advance (提前) that you will not be there and give your direct reason to them. Don't forget to apologize if you are absent from the invitation.

When you have accepted the invitation to a party or a dinner, it is polite to bring small presents with you, such as drinks, flowers and chocolate. Sometimes Westerners may take you out to dinner in a restaurant and it does not mean that he is going to pay the bill at the end of the meal. He might want to "go Dutch", which means each person pays his own bill.

If you don't want to cause many misunderstanding, it's helpful to learn from what is mentioned above.





